North Sea Supply Base

The North Sea Supply Base is the most recent of AV Dawson's acquisitions and has greatly enhanced the variety of services we can provide. The 9 hectare site was formerly used for fabrication of offshore structures. As well as allowing us to expand our wharfage operations and our products and services base, it has enabled us to serve the needs of industry, offering short and long term property rentals.

The site offers rental opportunities for companies who wish to use 15,000 sq m of factory space, over 5,000 sq m of warehousing and extensive office accommodation, and offers a one-stop shop for any offshore and onshore related engineering requirement.

There are three main fabrication halls, each one over 2,650 sq m in area, measuring 65m long by 36m wide, with a door opening of up to 32m wide. Each hall has three overhead cranes and each crane has two ten tonne hoists and one five tonne hoist giving a max. 60 tonne lift. The halls are 45m high with 33m from crane hooks to floor.



Setting the Standards



These capacious facilities allow clients to build large offshore structures too big for their own facilities or indeed too big for conventional road transport. The main fabrication halls are supported by smaller units and a shotblasting and painting facility, providing all of the back-up services required for even the largest projects. The completed structures can then be loaded or lifted out for transportation using our on-site heavy lift crane and loadout quay.



Decommissioning of Offshore platforms and modules is a market that North Sea Supply Base is ready to take on. It has been said that the best place to decommission is the place that modules were built, that is certainly the case with North Sea Supply Base, the site has over twenty years of experience in this field.

We have partnerships with waste management companies and local fabricators who are tried and tested in the “reverse engineering” of this type of project.

The site has project accommodation for up to 500 people, including canteens, shower rooms and project offices. These can be rented on a weekly basis and the options range from a single office to an 1000 sq m amenity facility right next to the fabrication halls.

Security is an important factor to North Sea Supply Base and the base benefits from 24 hour manned guarding with traffic control, CCTV and monitored alarm systems.
